IV. **RFP –Community Corrections for Community Recidivism**

Recently closed RFP for Community Corrections for Community Recidivism Services. This was part of a \$50,000 grant. A piece of the grant was awarded to Trilogy who will establish a web-based network of care where probation clients can access information related to employment, health, a library learning center, housing assistance etc.

V. **Leadership for Life**

AB109 services are located at Trident Center; Mental Health, Sheriff, Human Services, Family Support, etc. Wraparound services since 2013, are free - there are 10 workshops: basic skills, CPR, kids, health fitness, resume, shopping for interview cloths and others.
