AVAILABLE SERVICES

Outpatient

Serves: Youth and Adults

Services Available: Less Intensive community based services (up to 6 hours per week for Youth and up to 9 hours per week for Adults) that include group counseling, patient education, individual counseling, crisis assistance, and case management.

Intensive Outpatient

Serves: Youth and Adults

Services Available: More intensive community-based services (6 to 19 hours per week for Youth and 9 to 19 hours per week for adults) that include group counseling, patient education, individual counseling, crisis assistance, and case management.

Opioid Treatment Program

Serves: Adults with opioid use disorder

Services Available: Prescribe medications (methadone, buprenorphine, naloxone), as well as provide case management, and group and individual counseling.

Withdrawal Management (Level 1)

Serves: Youth (if authorized) and Adults

Services Available: Outpatient services with or without medication services for up to 14 days while also participating in outpatient counseling.

AVAILABLE SERVICES

(continued)

Residential-A Preauthorized Service

Serves: Youth and Adults

Services Available: Short-term residential services are determined by medical necessity and include group counseling, patient education, individual counseling, and crisis assistance and case management.

Recovery Support Services

Serves: Youth and Adults – Post Treatment

Services Available: Support services available after treatment completion, including group counseling, individual counseling, relapse prevention, recovery coaching, and case management. (Available up to 6 months)

ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICES

Youth (12 to 17 years of age), young adults and adults (18 years of age and older) who meet the following eligibility requirements can access no-cost (free) substance use treatment services in Merced County:

1. **Be enrolled in or eligible for Medi-Cal.**
2. **Be a resident of Merced County (proof may be required if you Medi-Cal benefits are assigned to another California County).**
3. **Need substance use treatment services based upon an assessment (what is known as “meeting medical necessity” requirements).**

HOW TO FIND SERVICES

There are three ways that you may begin with your substance use treatment:

3. **Schedule an appointment with the Central Access to Recovery Services (CARS) unit or walk-in for a same day appointment.**

Remember, you do not need to begin this journey alone. Someone from your family, caregiver or healthcare provider can help you call or connect with a treatment provider.

Just like diabetes or hypertension, substance abuse is a chronic condition that typically requires long term treatment. Do not hesitate to continue or come back for treatment or connect with recovery support services if you think you may relapse or if you did relapse. Treatment providers will be there to help!
