check for tightness and proper placement. Staff will transport the subject in the restraint to a designated location in the classroom using proper transporting techniques. Staff will place and secure the subject in The Wrap Carry Cart and will transport the subject along a designated route. Activity: Staff will properly remove The Wrap restraint.

Instructor will observe staff communication with each other and working as a team to remove the restraint.

Activity: Staff will properly decontaminate The Wrap restraint and place it back in the storage bag.

Instructor will observe that The Wrap restraint is properly decontaminated and placed back in the storage bag properly for quick removal and set up for the next time The Wrap restraint needs to be utilized.

1 0920 0930 Documentation: Any time a staff member utilizes The Wrap restraint, a "Restraint Device Assessment for Transportation within the facility" form shall be completed and an incident report generated.

- Documentation of what time medical/mental health was contacted and what time they responded in the incident report.

- Documentation of what time medical/mental health was contacted regarding the use of prolonged restraints shall also be included in the incident report.
