As a result of the passage of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Merced County received an allocation of nearly \$54 million. These funds can be used to:

- Support the public health response
- Address negative economic impacts
- Replace public sector revenue loss
- Provide premium pay for essential workers
- Make necessary investments in water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure

Information gathered from the survey will help inform the Board of Supervisors on how to use the ARPA funding to provide long-lasting benefits to local residents.
