UPCOMING ELECTION

Statewide Direct
Primary Election
June 7, 2022

- Voting Assistance Centers will be 11 day centers, and 4 day centers.
- 11 Day Voting Assistance Centers will run May 28th-June 6th from 8am-4pm
- 4 Day Voting Assistance Centers will run June 4th-June 6th from 8am-4pm
- **Primary Election Day:**
June 7, 2022
7am – 8pm

SOCIAL DISTANCING/SANITATION

- **Sanitization Stations:** We have a designated table at each Voting Assistance Center for sanitation purposes, after each use, a member of our team will sanitize the voting booth as well as any equipment used. We have also provided hand sanitizer at all tables.
- **Social Distancing:** Layouts have been created for each Voting Assistance Center to not only help with setting up the VAC, but also as a guide for voters to flow through the assistance center with ease, distance, and accessibility.
- **Signage:** Each voting booth has a laminated place card to reflect that the booth has been thoroughly sanitized and is ready for use.
- **Equipment:** Use of disposable paper “I Voted” stylus for signing the poll pad, as well as for use on the ExpressVote.



EXPRESSVOTE

The paper-based ExpressVote Universal Voting System uses touch-screen technology that produces a paper record for tabulation. As a marker, the ExpressVote handles the entire marking process.

- Accessible to voters with hearing and sight impairments
