1	0830	0850	<p>As officers arrive at the training area they will be physically checked twice to ensure there are no weapons or ammunition on them, once by a fellow officer and once by an instructor.</p> <p>The officers will then be allowed to enter the staging/scenario area where no live ammunition or weapons are allowed. Should anyone, including instructors, leave the staging/scenario area for any reason, they will be checked by two officers prior to re-entering the staging area.</p> <p>Instructors will welcome the officers and introduce the subject matter, expectations, and safety rules.</p> <p>Instructors will introduce the two training scenarios that the officers will participate in.</p>	"Lecture"	"Amancio-Sanchez, Ricardo", "Garcia, Jason", "Granados, Jose", "Haberman, Christopher", "Hernandez, Marissa"	
1	0850	0935	<p>At the start of the scenario, the instructor playing Davis will be standing at the 7-yard line pacing back and forth talking to himself. He will not respond to any of the officer's commands. As the officers approach to apprehend him, Davis will pull out a knife and tell the officers not to come any closer. He will hold the knife down by his side and continue to pace back and forth.</p> <p>Instructors in the yellow safety vests will be observing how quickly the officers recognize the threat, their attempts to de-escalate the situation, the communication between the officers, radio usage, use of less-lethal force options, transition to lethal force, and tactical positioning.</p> <p>At the end of the scenario, the instructors will ask the officers to talk them through the scenario on what they observed and did. contact him he will turn around and walk into the sims house. The officers will enter the house and start to clear the residence in an attempt to locate Maduro. While the officers are clearing the residence, Maduro will pop out from a room, shoot at the officers, then go back into the room. Officers will have to react to the shots fired. Instructors will be observing the officers and will watch for officer communication, radio usage, tactical positioning, and tactical retreat from the residence.

At the end of the scenario, instructors will ask the officers to talk them through the scenario on what they observed and did. Instructors will provide feedback on what the officers did well and what they could improve upon. Officers will be taken back to the staging area to return all of the training equipment.
